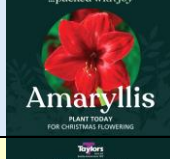

Week 38/3rd week September	Layered Planting Pot	Did you know that you can plant multiple different bulbs in layers in one pot to flower next spring? Choose Narcissus, Tulips, Hyacinth, Crocus or Muscari and follow the instructions on the packs		Taylors Layered Planting Range
Week 39/4th week September	Indoor flowering Hyacinth	Make sure you plant choose your prepared (indoor) hyacinth to plant for indoor colour and fragrance this winter. Choose your prepared hyacinth bulbs, a suitable planter (bowls or baskets are perfect) and bulb fibre compost. Plant the bulbs so the neck of the bulb is just above the surface of the bulb fibre. Water and place in a frost free place at a maximum teperature of 9 degreec C. Check them weekly and after 10-12 weeks (this is to allow the roots to form), when the flower bud is showing bring them into a warm, light room ready for flowering. Week 40/end September	Grow Your Own Saffron	Did you know that you can plant Crocus sativus bulbs to grow your own saffron? Crocus sativus is the "saffron crocus" and the red filaments of the flowers can be picked and dried ready for cooking.		Crocus sativus
